ORDINANCE NO. 2730

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD AMENDING  
SECTION 8-41.1(A)(1) OF THE OXNARD CITY CODE  
(Parking of Oversized Vehicles)

The City Council of the City of Oxnard does ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 8-41.1(A)(1) of the Oxnard City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(1) “Oversized vehicle” means any motor vehicle, as defined by the Cal. Vehicle Code, Section 670:

(a) That exceeds 96 inches in height, exclusive of such projecting devices as are expressly allowed pursuant to the Cal. Vehicle Code, and exceeds 240 inches in length; or

(b) That is attached to a trailer, as defined by the Cal. Vehicle Code, Section 630, regardless of the combined height and length of the motor vehicle and attached trailer.”

Part 2. Within 15 days after passage, the City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. Ordinance No. 2730 was first read on November 28, 2006 and finally adopted on \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_ to become effective thirty days thereafter.
