SUBJECT: Update on Permit Parking Program

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider a report regarding the implementation of the Pilot Permit Parking Program and provide direction to staff.

DISCUSSION

City Council has requested an update on the Pilot Permit Parking Program.

The Project. The City Council approved Ordinance No. 2702 on September 20, 2005, establishing a Pilot Permit Parking Program in the Fremont South Neighborhood. Permits were available at the end of March 2006. Informational flyers were distributed to residents at the end of March 2006 informing them when permits would be available and where to obtain them. City crews began posting signs at the end of March block by block.

The Area. The pilot permit parking area consists of the residential frontage bounded by Magnolia Avenue to the north, the west side of H Street to the east, Second Street (but not including) to the south, and Ventura Road frontage road to the west.
