SUBJECT: Contract for Professional Services with ComCo Management, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute Agreement A-6884 with ComCo Management, Inc. in the amount of \$680,000 for providing a workers' compensation third-party administrator for fiscal years 2007 to 2009.

DISCUSSION

Since the early 1980's, the Workers' Compensation Division has contracted with third-party administrators to provide claims management services for their workers' compensation program. In January 2007, a Request for Proposals (RFP) for third party administrator services for the City's workers' compensation program was initiated to ensure that the City was receiving the most competitive pricing and highest quality services for their workers' compensation program.

Fifteen proposals were received as a result of the RFP. These were reviewed to ensure that they met all the established criteria as listed in the RFP. From the original responses, the top four submissions were invited to be interviewed by a committee made up of representatives from the Finance Department, Human Resources, colleagues in the field of workers' compensation from the City of Simi Valley and the County of Ventura.

Oral interviews were conducted on April 24, 2007 of the top four candidates. A series of questions were asked to evaluate the company's technical skills, customer service delivery and claim management success. Based on the recommendations from the committee and a thorough review by the Workers' Compensation Division, staff recommends that the City of Oxnard select ComCo Management as the Third Party Administrator for their workers' compensation program.
