SUBJECT: Results of the Canvass of Returns of the General Municipal Election Held on November 4, 2008.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council adopt a resolution stating the results of the canvass of the returns of the general municipal election held on November 4, 2008.

DISCUSSION

On June 24, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 13,494 calling for the municipal election requesting consolidation of the City's election, requesting the County Clerk to render services and supplies to the City for election, and authorizing the Board of Supervisors to canvass the returns. The Board of Supervisors certified the canvass of the November 4, 2008 general municipal election with the highest number of voters received by Thomas E. Holden for Mayor; Irene Pinkard and Bryan MacDonald for City Council; Danielle Navas for City Treasurer; and Daniel Martinez for City Clerk.

The Board of Supervisors certified the canvass of the general municipal election with Measure O passing by receiving more than fifty percent of the votes cast. The Board of Supervisors also certified the canvass of the general municipal election with respect to Measure V having failed to receive more than fifty percent of the votes cast.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Staff requested and received funding of \$44,800 (Acct. No. 101-1302-801-8477) to cover the costs of the election. Staff will submit final costs when received from the County Clerk's Office.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD STATING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION RETURNS FROM THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2008.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oxnard called for a general municipal election in the City on November 4, 2008, to elect a Mayor for a term of two years, two Councilmembers for the term of four years, one City Treasurer for a term of four years, one City Clerk for a term of four years, and to consider Measure "O" and Measures "V"; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was duly given in the time, form, and manner provided by law, and the election was held on the above date, and the votes cast were canvassed and the returns thereof made at time and in the manner and form provided by law; and

WHEREAS, on this 9th day of December, 2008, the City Council duly assembled at its usual place of meeting and received the certification of the election from the County Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oxnard resolves:

1. That a general municipal election was held on November 4, 2008, that the votes cast were duly canvassed, and that the returns were made at the time, in the form and in the manner required by law.
2. That the absentee voter ballots were canvassed and counted as required by law.
3. That this City Council has reviewed the canvass of the returns of the election and from the returns it appears, and this City Council finds, that the whole number of votes cast in the City in the election, the names of the persons voted for and for what office each person was voted for, the number of votes cast at each precinct at the election and for each person, the total number of votes given in the City to each person, and the total number of votes given to each Measure, are as shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
4. That Thomas E. Holden received the highest number of votes for the office of Mayor and is hereby declared to be elected.
5. That Irene Pinkard and Bryan MacDonald received the highest number of votes for the two Councilmember offices and are hereby declared to be elected.

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6. That Danille Navas received the highest number of votes for the office of City Treasurer and is hereby declared to be elected.

7. That Daniel Martinez received the highest number of votes for the office of City Clerk and is hereby declared to be elected.

8. That Measure "O" was approved by the voters, receiving more than fifty percent of votes cast.

9. That Measure "V" failed to receive more than fifty percent of the votes cast.


