ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD
AMENDING THE TITLE OF CITY CODE SECTION 7-125 AND ADDING
SUBSECTIONS 7-125(C), 7-125(D), AND 7-125(E) TO THE CITY CODE
CONCERNING THE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL IN CITY PARKS

The City Council of the City of Oxnard does ordain as follows:

Part 1. The title of Oxnard City Code (“OCC”) section 7-125 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SEC. 7-125. POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.”

Part 2. Subsections 7-125(C), 7-125(D), and 7-125(E) are hereby added to the OCC to read as follows:

“(C) No person shall possess in any City park any can, bottle, or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage that has been opened, or a seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.”

“(D) The City may issue a civil citation to any person who violates subsection (C) or prosecute such violation as an infraction.”

“(E) A person shall not be in violation of subsection (C) when that person is in possession of an alcoholic beverage container for the purpose of recycling or other related activity.”


