SUBJECT: Sixth Amendment to Agreement for Consulting Services Between the City of Oxnard and Kennedy Jenks Consultants for Redwood Trunk Sewer Project

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council

1. Approve and authorize the Mayor to execute a Sixth Amendment to Agreement with Kennedy Jenks Consultants in the amount of \$28,328 for Consulting Services between the City of Oxnard and Kennedy Jenks Consultants for the Redwood Trunk Sewer Project (Agreement No. 2099-04-PW).
2. Approve the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$28,328 from the Wastewater Collection Operating Fund to the Redwood Trunk Sewer Project, for Consulting Services between the City of Oxnard and Kennedy Jenks Consultants.

DISCUSSION

Staff recommends continuing the City's agreement for consulting services with Kennedy Jenks Consultants for additional engineering and evaluation services that were identified during the construction of the Redwood Trunk Sewer Project. The Sixth Amendment will amend the scope of services to include services such as providing technical support to the City on Redwood Trunk Sewer Project contractor Affholder's request for change orders issues including intermediate jacking stations, dewatering, groundwater conditions, unidentified utilities (approximately seven locations), shaft design and location and differing site conditions which include obstructions, cobbles and quartz content. The cost of these services is \$28,328 and will increase the agreement value from \$895,144 to \$923,472.

**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
FOR CONSULTING SERVICES**

This Sixth Amendment to Agreement for Consulting Services, dated August 29, 2008, is entered into by and between the City of Oxnard, a municipal corporation ("City"), and Kennedy Jenks Consultants ("Consultant"), and amends that certain Agreement for Consulting Services ("the Agreement") entered into on the 2nd day of January, 2004, as amended by the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Amendment thereto.

City and Consultant agree that the agreement is amended as follows:


1. In Section 14 of the Agreement, "City agrees to pay Consultant \$895,144" is deleted and replaced with "City agrees to pay Consultant \$923,144".
2. Exhibit A1 of the Agreement Scope of Services is supplemented by Exhibit A2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

City and Consultant further agree that as amended, the Agreement remains in full force and effect.







SCOPE OF SERVICES

TASK H – ENGINEERING EVALUATION DURING CONSTRUCTION - \$28,328
