SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with WorleyParsons Komex for Rice Avenue/Santa Clara Avenue Interchange Improvements at Highway 101

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute the first amendment to the agreement with WorleyParsons Komex in the amount of \$59,125.50 (total agreement of \$599,780.60) for remediation of contamination at the Rice Avenue/Santa Clara Avenue interchange improvements on U.S. Highway 101 (Agreement No. A-6920).

DISCUSSION

City Council approved the professional services agreement with WorleyParsons Komex on January 15, 2008. The original scope of work implements the corrective action plan to remediate the contamination at 3025 Santa Clara Avenue, the site of the former gas station and hotel purchased for the Rice Avenue/Santa Clara Avenue interchange improvements at Highway 101. The first amendment increases the scope of work and fee to reflect additional work required to locate and repair the groundwater monitoring wells and prepare other work for the construction of the interchange.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are sufficient appropriations in the Rice Avenue/Highway 101 Interchange Project No. 873114 to fund this request.
