SUBJECT: Establishment of a Cultural Arts Committee

RECOMMENDATION

- 1) That City Council, consider formation of a committee of two Councilmembers to direct implementation of the City Cultural Arts Plan, and to make recommendations to the City Council;
- 2) If such a committee is formed, that the Mayor, with the approval of City Council, appoint two Councilmembers to constitute the committee.

DISCUSSION

At its meeting of January 25, 2011, City Council briefly discussed possible formation of a committee to provide leadership on arts related issues. In 2008, Mayor Pro-Tem Herrera formed a steering committee to guide the development of the City Cultural Arts Plan. Based upon the January 25, 2011 discussion, it is recommended that a Council committee be formed to provide direction in the implementation of the Plan.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with the requested action. Implementation of the Cultural Arts Plan is in part dependent of funding to be provided by in-lieu fees and grant funds.
