**SUBJECT:** Fourth Amendment to Agreement with Olin Chlor-Alkali Products for Chemical Supply and Delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite to the Wastewater Treatment Plant (Agreement No. A-7141)

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute a Fourth Amendment with Olin Chlor-Alkali Products (Agreement No. A-7141) to increase the compensation by \$290,000 for a not to exceed total of \$870,000 and extend the contract expiration date to June 30, 2012.

**DISCUSSION**

Sodium Hypochlorite is an essential chemical used in the Wastewater Treatment Plant in order to comply with air and water quality regulations. Sodium hypochlorite is added to incoming sewage for odor control and to the final effluent to disinfect the water before discharge to the ocean.

On January 7, 2009, the City’s Purchasing Division and Water Resources Division Wastewater Section sent out a competitive Request for Bid (RFB) for chemical supply and delivery of three (3) water treatment chemicals: ferric chloride, sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite. The RFB was distributed to five (5) regional treatment chemical supply companies with a closing bid date of January 27, 2009. Two (2) of the five (5) vendors responded with bids; Olin Chlor-Alkali Products (Olin Chlor) and Basic Chemical Solutions, LLC. Olin Chlor submitted the lowest bid.

On March 3, 2009, the City Council approved and authorized the Mayor to execute the original Agreement with Olin Chlor for the period from March 3, 2009, through February 28, 2010, with the option for three (3) additional one (1) year periods, if agreed upon by both parties. This Fourth Amendment represents the second optional extension.

Fourth Amendment with Olin Chlor-Alkali Products for Chemical Supply and  
Delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite to the Wastewater Treatment Plant  
(Agreement No. A-7141)  
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The Public Works Department is currently preparing a request for bids for sodium hypochlorite and other chemicals for both the Wastewater Treatment Plant and the new Advanced Water Purification Facility in advance of the June 2012 completion of this recommended term extension.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The Fourth Amendment will increase the Agreement compensation by \$290,000 for a total not to exceed \$870,000. The recommended FY 2011-12 Budget includes funds in the Wastewater Treatment Operation Fund Account Number 621-6202-843-8104 to cover the cost of this Amendment.

**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR TRADE SERVICES**

This Fourth Amendment ("Fourth Amendment") to the Agreement for Trade Services ("Agreement") is made and entered into in the County of Ventura, State of California, this 28th day of June, 2011, by and between the City of Oxnard, a municipal corporation ("City"), and Olin Chlor-Alkali Products ("Vendor"). This Fourth Amendment amends the Agreement entered into on March 3, 2009, by City and Vendor. The Agreement previously has been amended on February 23, 2010, by a First Amendment, on October 10, 2010, by a Second Amendment, and on February 17, 2011 by a Third Amendment.

City and Vendor agree as follows:

1. In section 3 of the Agreement the date "June 30, 2011" is deleted and replaced by the date "June 30, 2012."
2. In section 4 of the Agreement the amount "\$580,000" is deleted and replaced with the figure "\$870,000."
3. As so amended, the Agreement remains in full force and effect.


