**SUBJECT:** Agreement for Professional Services with Siemens Industry, Inc. for Comprehensive Remote Surveillance Program

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute an Agreement for Professional Services (A-7419) with Siemens Industry, Inc. in the amount of \$300,000 to develop the City's comprehensive remote surveillance system.

**DISCUSSION**

In September 2010, the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (USDJ COPS), awarded \$300,000 to the City of Oxnard to further develop its comprehensive citywide remote surveillance program. The total budget for this project is \$300,000.

City Purchasing distributed a Request for Proposal to 13 potential vendors for this scope of work; only two vendors submitted bids. A selection panel convened and Siemens Industry, Inc. was selected as the preferred vendor.

The focus of the project is to provide the City with a comprehensive approach to managing the existing video feeds into the security Operations Center (SOC), as well as to develop a master plan to incrementally integrate additional stand-alone systems as funding becomes available. Siemens Industry, Inc. will replace Legacy Video Systems at the SOC, Water Distribution Facility, and the Transportation Center. Siemens Industry, Inc. will also relocate the SOC to a more suitable workspace, taking the Oxnard Downtown Management District's former office location within the downtown parking structure. The outcome will be a unified video management platform, giving SOC operators the ability to view and manipulate video as needed to properly administer remote surveillance. A one-year warranty on parts and labor is included in this project bid.
