**SUBJECT:** PW10-06 Del Norte Boulevard Arterial Resurfacing Project

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council approve Project Specification No. PW10-06 for pavement resurfacing along Del Norte Boulevard between Sturgis Road and Highway 101 and authorize staff to solicit bids for the project.

**DISCUSSION**

The project involves resurfacing Del Norte Boulevard to include furnishing of all materials, equipment, and labor required for pavement resurfacing, traffic markings, medians and signage, improvements to sidewalk, curbs, gutters, and other concrete structures.

Del Norte Boulevard serves as a major north/south arterial for commuters and commerce entering the northeast industrial region of Oxnard. Over the last three decades continued traffic use from heavy-duty commercial vehicles on Del Norte Boulevard has weakened its road surface beyond what routine repair and maintenance can do to stabilize its condition.


The project plans and specifications include reconstruction of certain areas and use of an asphalt-rubber aggregate membrane (ARAM) system with a 2-inch hot rubber asphalt overlay to provide a durable road surface for the projected traffic loading. The proposed improvements will be an economic benefit not only to the businesses along the route but to the City as a whole.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The City is currently seeking Transportation grant funding for this project. When staff returns to Council for authorization to award a contract, a funding plan will be presented for Council consideration.
