**SUBJECT:** Transmittal of Adopted 2030 General Plan Goals and Policies Document.

**RECOMMENDATION**

That the City Council receive and file the 2030 General Plan.

**DISCUSSION**

The 2030 General Plan consists of two operative documents, the Background Report, completed in 2006, and the final version of the Goals and Policies. The October 11, 2011 resolution adopting the Goals and Policies required staff to transmit the final version of the 2030 General Plan to the City Council at the second regularly scheduled City Council meeting date after the effective date. The effective date was November 12, 2011 and there were no challenges to the 2030 General Plan Program Environmental Impact Report within the challenge period that ended November 18, 2011.

Both documents are hereby formally transmitted to the City Council. The 2030 General Plan operative and supporting documents are available at the City's libraries, on the City's Internet homepage, and on CD from the Planning Division office at 214 South C Street during regular business hours.
