SUBJECT: **First Amendment to Agreement for Street Sweeping Services with Venco Power Sweeping, Inc.**

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement with Venco Power Sweeping, Incorporated (Venco) for street sweeping services to streets recently conveyed and incorporated to the City in the amount of \$6,848. (Agreement No. A-7030).

DISCUSSION

Sweeping is provided on all City streets, alleyways, arterials, and public parking lots at various intervals ranging from weekly to monthly to maintain and enhance the City's appearance. Adequate sweeping ensures compliance with permit requirements for storm water discharge from the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. For the past several years, the City has contracted for street sweeping service. Approximately 19,600 curb miles are currently swept annually.

The scope of services in the current agreement with Venco provides for bi-weekly sweeping of residential streets, weekly sweeping of downtown streets, and weekly to monthly sweeping of arterials and parking lots. The initial term of the Agreement began April 1, 2008, and continues through March 31, 2010. Subsequent to the start of the contract, the City has or will add a total of 18.6 curb miles related to the conveyance of Victoria Avenue from Teal Club Road to the City's corporate limits just south of the Santa Clara River crossing and the relinquishment of Oxnard Boulevard from U.S. Route 101 to the intersection of Rice Avenue and Pleasant Valley Road, Vineyard Avenue from U.S. Route 101 to Oxnard Boulevard, and Fifth Street from Oxnard Boulevard to Rice Avenue.

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Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with Venco will include an expanded scope of services to provide street sweeping services to the newly incorporated streets as follows:

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Based on Venco's service rates and the initial two-year term of the Agreement, the estimated current value of this Agreement is \$779,260. The cost of the First Amendment is \$6,847.75 through the contract term of March 31, 2010, bringing the total cost of the agreement to \$786,108. Funds in the amount of \$6,848 are available in Account No. 212-3103-803-8209.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR STREET SWEEPING SERVICES

This First Amendment ("First Amendment") to the Agreement for Street Sweeping Services ("Agreement") is made and entered into in the County of Ventura, State of California, this 13th day of January, 2008, by and between the City of Oxnard, a municipal corporation ("City"), and Venco Power Sweeping, Inc. ("Contractor"). This First Amendment amends the Agreement entered into on April 8, 2008, by City and Contractor.

City and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Effective March 10, 2009, the table following the heading of Paragraph 10 of Exhibit A of the Agreement is replaced by Paragraph 10 in ExhibitA-2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. As so amended, the Agreement remains in full force and effect.




