SUBJECT: Traffic Signal Modifications at Various Locations Project

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve plans and specifications of Project Specification No. PW 09-07 for traffic signal modifications at Wooley Road and Patterson Road, Ventura Road and Town Center Drive, Gonzales Road and C Street, Gonzales Road and H Street, C Street and Second Street, C Street and Fourth Street, C Street and Sixth Street, C Street and Hill Street.

DISCUSSION

To increase safety and make intersections operate more efficiently, staff has identified existing intersections where modifications are needed to correct deficiencies. The following table identifies the locations of traffic signal intersections and recommended modifications:

Location of Intersection	Modification
Wooley Road and Patterson Road	Provide protected left turn phase
Ventura Road and Town Center Drive	Replace all existing non standard equipment
Gonzales Road and C Street	Replace all existing non standard equipment such as old and rusted poles
Gonzales Road and H Street	Modify median and provide protected left turn phase
C Street and Second Street	Replace all existing non standard equipment such as old and rusted poles

C Street and Fourth Street	Replace all existing non standard equipment such as old and rusted poles
C Street and Sixth Street	Replace all existing non standard equipment such as old and rusted poles
C Street and Hill Street	Replace all existing non standard equipment such as old and rusted poles

On February 17, 2009 President Barack Obama signed into law the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Recovery Act) that provides an economic stimulus plan totaling \$787 billion for the national economy. The stimulus package provides local governments with billions of dollars to fund infrastructure projects such as road and transportation systems. The traffic signal modifications recommended in this report are eligible for funding under the Recovery Act. Projects must be obligated (i.e. construction contract awarded) within 120 days from the date the Recovery Act was signed into law. The City of Oxnard has requested \$740,000 for this through Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost for the traffic signal modifications which includes design, project management, materials, inspection and construction is \$740,000. If awarded, funding from the Recovery Act should be sufficient for the cost of this project. Upon receiving funding from the Recovery Act, staff will return to City Council to recommend an appropriation of those funds. If funding from the Recovery Act is not received, this project will be deferred until another funding source is available.
