**SUBJECT:** Ordinance Amending the Definition of "Disaster Service Worker"

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council approve the first reading by title only and subsequent adoption of an ordinance amending the definition of "disaster service worker" set forth in subdivision (A) of section 6-2 of the Oxnard City Code.

**DISCUSSION**

Pursuant to California Government Code section 3100, all public employees are declared to be disaster service workers should a disaster occur. The proposed ordinance would update the definition of "disaster service worker" in the Oxnard City Code so it is consistent with all definitions set forth in State law.

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OXNARD

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
OXNARD AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "DISASTER  
SERVICE WORKER" SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION (A) OF  
SECTION 6-2 OF THE OXNARD CITY CODE

The City Council of the City of Oxnard does ordain as follows:

**Part 1.** Subdivision (A) of section 6-2 of the Oxnard City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(A) DISASTER SERVICE WORKER – A person defined as a disaster service worker in Cal. Gov't Code section 3101 and Cal. Labor Code section 3211.92."

**Part 2.** Within 15 days after passage, the City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. 
