**SUBJECT:** Application for California Gang Reduction, Intervention, and Prevention (CalGRIP) Initiative Grant Funding

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit an application for \$400,000 in California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) and the Governor’s Office of Gang and Youth Violence Policy (OGYVP) California Gang Reduction, Intervention, and Prevention (CalGRIP) Cities Initiative funds to be used to reduce gang and youth violence through the mentoring and structured activities of underperforming middle school students and siblings.

**DISCUSSION**

The City of Oxnard is eligible to submit a grant application with CalEMA for consideration of state funds of up to \$400,000 over a two year period. The CalGRIP grant is designed to provide funding to select cities for gang prevention, intervention, reentry, education, job training and skills development, family and community services, and suppression activities.

The grant funds will be used in conjunction with the Oxnard Alliance for Community Strength Project and will provide funding for City Corps and other select community based organizations in the city’s effort to eliminate gang and youth violence. The deadline for submission of the grant is January 12, 2010.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT**

Approval of this recommendation will not require a local match contribution from the general fund. A special budget appropriation will be requested upon grant award.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD APPROVING  
SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No. 12,053 sets out the procedure by which City staff may submit grant applications, following approval by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has requested that City Council authorize the City Manager to submit an application for \$400,000 to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (OES) for California Gang Reduction, Intervention, and Prevention (CalGRIP) Initiative grant funds to be used to reduce gang and youth gun violence through focused deterrence and employment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oxnard resolves to approve the submittal of a grant application by the City Manager. The City Council further resolves that the City Manager is authorized to execute grant agreement; the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to submit financial reports and grant claims and approve special budget appropriations for the use of grant funds; and the Chief of Police or designee is authorized to submit non-financial reports.


