SUBJECT: Application for Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the Amount of \$105,000

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council adopt a resolution authorizing:

1. The City Manager to submit an application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) in the amount of \$105,000;
2. The City Manager or designee to execute the grant agreement if grant funds are awarded to the city;
3. The Chief Financial Officer or designee to submit financial reports, grant claims, and approve special budget appropriations for the use of grant funds, if grant funds are awarded to the City;
4. The Fire Chief or designee to submit non-financial reports.

DISCUSSION

The City of Oxnard is eligible to submit a grant application with FEMA for consideration of federal funds of \$105,000. Fire Departments are eligible to apply to the FEMA AFG to enhance their abilities to protect the public and fire service personnel from fire and related hazards. FEMA grants are awarded on a yearly basis. The grant funds will provide for hazardous materials technician training for fire department personnel, if awarded.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this recommendation will require the City of Oxnard to provide a 20% matching funds contribution of \$21,000 from the General Fund, if the grant is approved. Funds will be provided from account # 101-2201-802-83.43.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD APPROVING
SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No.12,053 sets out the procedure by which City staff may submit grant applications, following approval by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has requested that City Council authorize the City Manager to submit an application for \$105,000 to the FEMA Assistance to Firefighter grant funds to be used for hazardous materials response training.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oxnard resolves to approve the submittal of a grant application by the City Manager for hazardous materials response training. 
