SUBJECT: PW06-13 Blackstock North Neighborhood Resurfacing Project,
Located in the Historic Enhancement and Revitalization Project Area (HERO)

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve Project Specification No. PW06-13 (Blackstock North Neighborhood Resurfacing Project) for pavement resurfacing, sidewalk, curb and gutter repair, and replacement of street name signs throughout the Blackstock North Neighborhood within the boundaries north to East Channel Islands Boulevard, south to McMillan Avenue and Tamarac Street, west to Samuel Avenue and eastward to Sycamore Street and authorize staff to solicit bids for the project.

DISCUSSION

In November 2006, the City and the Community Development Commission authorized the sale, issuance, and delivery of the Oxnard Community Development Commission HERO Project Area Tax Allocation Bonds, Series 2006 ("Bonds"). Located in the HERO Project Area of Oxnard as a planned component of the Bonds, the Blackstock North Neighborhood Resurfacing Project adheres to the HERO Redevelopment Plan designed for improvements that will substantially modify, alter, repair, or rehabilitate this neighborhood community. Since these improvements will occur in the HERO Project Area of Oxnard, HERO Bonds will be used to fund the project specification.

The project's specifications include the furnishing of all materials, tools, equipment, and labor required to make necessary repairs to sidewalk, curbs, gutters, and other concrete structures, pavement resurfacing, traffic markings, and installation of new street name signs.

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
FINANCIAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimated cost for the project, which includes design, material testing, construction inspection, project management, administration, construction engineering, and construction, is \$2,046,280. There are sufficient funds in the HERO Street Projects No. 078701 for the estimated cost of this project. Staff believes that separate project numbers for the street resurfacing projects under HERO will provide each project with greater financial accounting controls.
