SUBJECT: **New Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Victoria Avenue and Gum Tree Street**

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council adopt Project Specification No. PW 10-01 for a new traffic signal at the intersection of Victoria Avenue and Gum Tree Street.

DISCUSSION

The intersection of Victoria Avenue and Gum Tree Street serves the Villa Victoria development east of Victoria Avenue northbound. Residents of the Villa Victoria are competing with high speed traffic on Victoria Avenue when exiting our entering the development. This signal will enable southbound access to Victoria Avenue.

Gold Coast Transit requested a bus stop to be constructed on Victoria Avenue for north and southbound, to provide transportation for the neighborhood residents.

The traffic signal project will construct the following:

- 1- New 3-way traffic signal.
- 2- Striping and signing modifications to provide for three (3) through vehicle lanes, and a bike lane for north and southbound traffic on Victoria Avenue at Gum Tree Street.
- 3- Raised center median with southbound left turn lane on Victoria Avenue north of Gum Tree Street.
- 4- Bus turnout with Bus Stop sign, bench and shelter on the west side of Victoria Avenue just south of Gum Tree Street.
- 5- Bus Stop sign, bench and shelter on the east side of Victoria Avenue just north of Gum Tree Street.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total estimated cost of this project is \$395,550. Funds from previously appropriated funds in the amount of \$890,000 in project account Villa Victoria Sign/ Drain 354-3028-826, and 371-3028-826 (083106) will be used to fund this project.
