SUBJECT: Second Amendment to Agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals for Chemical Supply and Delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite and Sodium Hydroxide to the Water Campus

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute the Second Amendment to the Agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals to increase the amount by \$332,564 for a total of \$997,692 for chemical supply and delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite and Sodium Hydroxide (Agreement No. A-7092), and extend the contract expiration date to August 31, 2011.

DISCUSSION

Sodium hydroxide and sodium hypochlorite are essential chemicals used in the treatment and delivery processes of Oxnard's local well water. On July 10, 2008, the City issued a competitive Request for Bid to qualified firms for supply and delivery of these chemicals. The closing date was July 29, 2008 and JCI Jones was the lowest bidder and the City awarded the contract to JCI Jones to supply and deliver sodium hydroxide and sodium hypochlorite. The City and JCI Jones Chemicals subsequently executed an agreement for one (1) year of supply and delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite and Sodium Hydroxide, with an option to extend up to two (2) additional one-year terms for a total cost not to exceed \$998,000. Execution of the Second Amendment would represent the final one-year extension.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost for services in the Second Amendment is not to exceed \$332,564 and will increase the total cost of the Agreement from \$665,128 to \$997,692. There are sufficient funds for the cost of these services in the Fiscal Year 2010/2011 Budget Fund 601.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR TRADE SERVICES

This Second Amendment ("Second Amendment") to the Agreement for Trade Services ("Agreement") is made and entered into in the County of Ventura, State of California, this 14th day of September, 2010, by and between the City of Oxnard, a municipal corporation ("City"), and JCI Jones Chemicals ("Vendor"). This Second Amendment amends the Agreement entered into on September 23, 2008, by City and Vendor. The Agreement previously has been amended on July 21, 2009, by a First Amendment.


City and Vendor agree as follows:




