**SUBJECT:** Second Amendment to Agreement with Olin Chlor-Alkali Products for Chemical Supply and Delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite to the Wastewater Treatment Plant (Agreement No. A-7141)

**RECOMMENDATION**

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute a Second Amendment with Olin Chlor-Alkali Products (Agreement No. A-7141) to increase the encumbrance an additional \$290,000 for a not to exceed total of \$580,000.

**DISCUSSION**

Sodium Hypochlorite is an essential chemical used in the Wastewater Treatment Plant in order to comply with air and water quality regulations. Sodium hypochlorite is added to incoming sewage for odor control and to the final effluent to disinfect the water before discharge to the ocean.

On January 7, 2009, the City's Purchasing Division and Water Resources Division Wastewater Section sent out a competitive Request for Bid (RFB) for chemical supply and delivery of three (3) water treatment chemicals: ferric chloride, sodium hypochlorite and sodium bisulfite. The RFB was distributed to five (5) regional treatment chemical supply companies with a closing bid date of January 27, 2009. Two (2) of the five (5) vendors responded with bids; Olin Chlor-Alkali Products (Olin Chlor) and Basic Chemical Solutions, LLC. Olin Chlor submitted the lowest bid.

On March 3, 2009, the City Council approved and authorized the Mayor to execute the original Agreement with Olin Chlor for the period from March 3, 2009, through February 28, 2010, with the option for three (3) additional one (1) year periods, if agreed upon by both parties. A First Amendment was approved administratively on the February 23, 2010 to extend the expiration date from February 28, 2010 to February 28, 2011. The Second Amendment will increase the agreement by \$290,000 for a total not to exceed \$580,000.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

The Second Amendment will increase the Agreement compensation by \$290,000 for a total not to exceed \$580,000. Funds are available in Account Number 621-6202-843-8104.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR TRADE SERVICES**

This Second Amendment ("Second Amendment") to the Agreement for Trade Services ("Agreement") is made and entered into in the County of Ventura, State of California, this 26th day of October, 2010, by and between the City of Oxnard, a municipal corporation ("City"), and Olin Chlor-Alkali Products ("Vendor"). 
