SUBJECT: **Approval of Award of Contract No. A-7529 for PW 06-93 Tierra Vista Neighborhood Street/Alley Resurfacing and Storm Drain Project**

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve and authorize the Mayor to execute Contract No. A-7529 with Toro Enterprises Inc. in the amount of \$4,081,028 for Project Specification Number 06-93 for the reconstruction of streets, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, alleyways, replacing street name signs and the installation of storm drain lines in the Tierra Vista Neighborhood (Tierra Vista Neighborhood Project).

DISCUSSION

On June 5, 2012, the City Council approved Project Specification Number 06-93 for the Tierra Vista Neighborhood Project. A pre-bid meeting was conducted on May 2, 2012 and was well attended by contractors. The bid opening was held on August 1, 2012, and six bids were received. The lowest responsible bidder was Toro Enterprises, Inc. of Oxnard for \$4,081,028.

The Tierra Vista Neighborhood Project is bounded eastward to Olds Road, westward to Lincoln Court, northward to Etting Road, and southward to Sanford Street as shown in Attachment No. 2. The specific work includes the furnishing of all materials, tools, equipment, and labor required to improve the streets from curb to curb, traffic markings, and installation of new street name signs, and minor work to sidewalks, curbs, gutters, alleyways and other concrete structures. The Project plans and specifications are designed to provide a useful life cycle of approximately 20 years to the streets, and over 20 years to curbs, gutters and sidewalks in the Tierra Vista Neighborhood. The project specifications are in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

In addition to the street improvements, the project specifications include the construction of a new storm drain system consisting of drain pipes and catch basins along Sanford Street, Olds Road, Reeder Avenue, Syracuse Drive, Tulsa Drive, Webster Drive, Alexander Drive, Peoria Place, Reading Drive, and other streets where no drainage system currently exists.

The new storm drain system is a subsection of the Rice Road Storm Drainage System, which conveys storm water to the ocean from a 5.34 square mile watershed area. This drainage system, when constructed, will mitigate chronic flooding problems within the project area especially at the street intersections. The lack of a proper drain system has caused the street pavement to deteriorate at a faster rate than streets with proper drainage. Street resurfacing of the Tierra Vista Neighborhood can begin once the construction of the storm drain system is completed.

On May 15, 2012, the City Council approved Measure O funding for street resurfacing of the Tierra Vista Neighborhood in conjunction with storm drain improvements funded by the Storm Drain Facilities Fees Fund. Additional funding needed for street resurfacing is available from the State Gas Tax. Measure O funding available in FY 2011-12 for ongoing maintenance and repair of alleyways is designated for 2,450 square feet of alleyway along Olds Road and Reeder Avenue and 950 square feet along Sanford Street. The subject alleyways are the only alleyways within the project area of the Tierra Vista Neighborhood.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are sufficient funds available from the Measure "O" Half-Cent Sales Tax in the amount of \$2,000,000, State Gas Tax in the amount of \$266,244, and Storm Drain Facilities Fees in the amount of \$1,814,784 for the Tierra Vista Neighborhood Improvement Project No. 043111.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Tierra Vista Neighborhood/Alley Resurfacing & Storm Drain –The project consists of the street resurfacing; reconstruction of alley to concrete pavement; and installation of storm drain line.

This is a contract for Public Work, as defined in Chapter 1 of Part 7 of Division 2 of the Labor Code, to which Labor Code Section 1771 applies. In providing services under this Contract, Contractor shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations, including the laws contained in Sections 1720 through 1861 of the California Labor Code. Contractor shall pay prevailing wages to all workers employed to provide services under this Contract.

This contract is made at Oxnard, California, as of this 23rd day of October, 2012, between the City of Oxnard, called herein the "City", and the above-named Contractor for the construction of the Capital Improvement Project described herein. The parties hereto agree as follows:

1. CONTRACT PRICE

Contractor shall perform the work described and the City shall pay the Contractor, in full payment for said work, the following sums for the following items:

See attached proposal bid schedule, which is made a part of this contract.

Total: \$4,081,028.86

The above sums include all taxes and the costs of any required bonds.

2. PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The City will pay the Contractor the contract price in accordance with Section 9.3 of the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction or in accordance with the following schedule if specified.

The Contractor may replace any payments retained by the City with securities in the same amount and the Contractor shall be the beneficial owner of said securities and interest earned (See Public Contract Code, Section 22300).

City shall make the final payment to Contractor by releasing amounts retained from progress payments made to Contractor. Such payment need not be made earlier than 35 days, and will be made no later than 60 days, after the project completion date indicated on the Notice of Completion for the Project. City shall withhold from such payment 125% of amounts claimed in stop notices filed in connection with the Project and 150% of amounts in dispute between City and Contractor.

3. THE WORK

Contractor shall furnish all tools, equipment, apparatus, facilities, labor and materials necessary to, and shall perform and complete in a good, safe and workmanlike manner, the work generally described as follows:

The scope of work consists of milling of asphalt pavement, placement and compaction of asphalt concrete and asphalt rubber aggregate membrane (ARAM), Type II slurry seal, stabilization of subgrade (digouts), concrete repairs, tree root removal, reconstruction of alley to concrete pavement, installation of storm drain lines, temporary striping and marking, adjusting utility covers to finish grade, traffic striping, installation of pavement markers, replacement of street signs, water pollution control, traffic control and detours.

The Risk Manager shall not approve or accept any endorsement if the endorsement contains "best effort" modifiers or if the insurer is relieved from the responsibility to give such notice.

4. 
