SUBJECT: Project Specification PW12-14 East Ventura Boulevard Improvement Project

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council approve Project Specification No. PW12-14 for the design and construction of sidewalk, curb, gutter, drainage, landscaping and the reconstruction of the street along East Ventura Boulevard from Nyeland Avenue to Almond Drive and authorize staff to solicit bids.

DISCUSSION

The specific work includes the furnishing of all materials, tools, equipment, and labor required to improve the sidewalk, curb, gutter, drainage, landscaping and the reconstruction of a bike lane along East Ventura Boulevard from Nyeland Avenue to Almond Drive. Attachment No. 1 provides a project site map. The Project plans and specifications are designed to provide a useful life cycle of approximately 20 years to all the improvements and are in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The City of Oxnard was awarded federal funds under the Surface Transportation Act (STA) for the design and construction of sidewalk, curb, gutter, drainage, landscaping and the reconstruction of the street along East Ventura Boulevard from Nyeland Avenue to Almond Drive.

The STA was established and is authorized by the Federal Government as federal aid for transportation projects that are administered by the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). City Resolution No. 13,807 approved by City Council on May 11, 2010 authorizes the City Manager to execute program supplement agreements for federal aid projects awarded to the City and administered by Caltrans.

FINANCIAL IMPACT


After the project bids are received and evaluated, staff will return to City Council to recommend approval of the lowest responsible bidder and the appropriation of federal funding and local match funding sources.
